Getting Started

2. What insight, principal, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling? Explain.

Read - Mark 6:14-29

3. What charge was John the Baptist bringing against King Herod?
4. What penalty did John ultimately pay due to Herodias's Grudge?
5. Who were the people saying Jesus was? What was Herod's response to this? Why?

Read - Mark 10:1-12

6. In light of what happened to John the Baptist, why did the Pharisees ask Jesus this question at this time? What was the test?

7. What would have been the result if Jesus would have condemned Herod's actions as well? How did Jesus respond?

8. Why did Jesus refer to Moses in response? How did His response point to the Pharisees?

Read - Malachi 2:15-16

9. Why does God hate divorce? What is God seeking through marriage? Why are we specifically told to guard ourselves in the spirit?

Going Deeper

10. As Christians we are called to study and model Christ as He interacts with others! How then should we treat those either dealing or having dealt with divorce according to John 4:7-18?

What role do you feel you best fit in God's design for marriage in your current season of life? How might you encourage each other in those roles?
