### Jesus Gone Missing

#### Getting Started

1. What did you love most about Easter growing up? Are there any traditions that you have continued with your own family? Why?
2. Of the five actions listed in Pastor Jason's message which do you have the hardest time accepting or doing? Why?
3. What insight, principal, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling? Explain.

Read - Mark 15:22-41

4. If crucifixion was "the most wretched of all ways of dying", why did Jesus refuse the pain-deadening narcotic offered to Him by the soldiers (v.23)?
5. What caused Jesus' separation from the Father? What does this say about our part in his crucifixion?
6. Which was worse for Jesus - the physical pain he endured or the darkness of experiencing Gods abandonment? (v.34) Can you relate?

7. What does the tearing of the temple curtain mean? How was direct access to God gained? Who gained access? How should this truth affect our lives and ministry?

Read- Matthew 28:1-20

8. Was the stone rolled back from the tomb so Jesus might get out or so that His followers might see and believe? What stones had (need) to be removed so you might see (more clearly) and believe (wholeheartedly)?
9. How did the women respond to what the angel told them? What was their reward on the road to obedience? What was their response to seeing Jesus?
10. Why do you think Matthew ended His gospel with verses 18-20? How do Jesus' words for His brothers "they WILL see me" (v.10) along with verse 20 inspire hope for us today?

Read- John 14:6

Why is the truth of the resurrection of Jesus imperative to this verse? How does this define who we are as Christ-followers?

How would you explain the importance of Christ's resurrection to a non-Christian?

How does your life reflect proof that the resurrection is real?
